1 **Louisiana Academy of Family Physicians** 2 2015 General Assembly 3 4 **RESOLUTION NO. 1** 5 **Background Checks and Education For Patients Regarding Gun Safety** 6 7 8 Submitted by: Dan Jens, MD - LAFP Vice-Speaker 9 10 WHEREAS, the Louisiana Academy of Family Physicians is concerned about prominent instances 11 12 of firearm related violence throughout our state and around our country, and 13 14 WHEREAS, the Louisiana Academy of Family Physicians feel the need to protect our patients and 15 communities from death or injury from firearms, therefore, be it 16 17 **RESOLVED**, that the Louisiana Academy of Family Physicians ask our Representatives to the 18 House of Representatives and our Senators to pass legislation to make background checks more 19 universal, and further be it 20 21 **RESOLVED**, that the Louisiana Academy of Family Physicians encourage its members to discuss 22 firearm safety with their patients, including issues that may include trigger locks, education 23 about handling guns and how to control anger. 24 25 26 **Background Information** 27 At its May, 2013 meeting, AAFP's Commission on Governmental Advocacy developed, and the 28 Board Chair approved in August 2013, a policy statement on background checks for gun sales: 29 30 **Prevention of Gun Violence** The federal requirement for an on-site background check should ensure that those who 31 32 have been convicted of a violent criminal offense and those who have been involuntarily 33 committed to a mental institution or otherwise adjudicated to be suffering a severe 34 mental condition posing a danger to others or themselves are not able to purchase 35 firearms. Therefore, this background-check requirement should be expanded to include 36 the sale of firearms at gun shows, over the Internet and in classified ads. Reasonable exceptions from the background check requirement should be allowed for sales between 37 38 immediate family members if the seller does not know or have reasonable cause to

believe that the purchaser is prohibited from receiving or possessing a firearm under
