## **RESOLUTION NO 1.**

## **ABFM Misinformation Disinformation Policies**

1 WHEREAS, the LAFP supports a physician's ability to speak freely without retribution; and 2 WHEREAS, the American Board of Family Medicine (ABFM) has adopted Professionalism 3 Guidelines policies effective September 22, 2022, that call for sanctioning physicians that 4 allegedly spread "misinformation" or "disinformation"; and 5 6 WHEREAS, the ABFM has decertified family medicine physicians for allegedly spreading 7 "misinformation" or "disinformation"; and 8 9 WHEREAS, on June 16, 2024 the U.S. Court of Appeals for the 5th Circuit ruled in favor of the 10 First Amendment establishing the right to object in court to censorship of physicians' speech on 11 topics ranging from government Covid policies to abortion; therefore be it 12 13 **RESOLVED**, that the LAFP adopt a policy stating that physicians have a protected First 14 15 Amendment right to free speech; and further be it 16 17 **RESOLVED**, that the LAFP oppose any action by the ABFM to censor, discipline or decertify physicians based on the ABFM disagreeing with the opinion of that physician; and further be it 18 19 **RESOLVED**, that the LAFP opposes the ABFM Professionalism Committee from determining what 20 is information communicated by any physician is false, inaccurate, misleading, misinformation or 21 disinformation. 22
